Guests are welcome to attend the colloquium, however for the reason stated above, we kindly ask that you inform us of their arrival. The abstracts, presentations as well as all relevant information should be sent to Korn@mpimp-golm.mpg.de, and the registered participants will receive the detailed programme in the Middle of November.
